RE: New Principal appointed at Marcus Oldham College

As previously communicated, Simon Livingstone is retiring at the end of this year after twenty-four years working for the College of which nineteen of those years were as Principal. What a mighty job he has done.

After an extensive search assisted by many alumni, and interviewing twenty-seven applicants in the last few months, it is our pleasure to announce Andrew Baker as the sixth Principal of Marcus Oldham College starting 1 January 2022. Many of you will know Andrew; he is currently the Director of both the Agriculture and Agribusiness courses and is an outstanding individual who, like many at Marcus Oldham, did not come from a traditional academic background (Summary CV is available here).

It makes us particularly proud that Andrew is an internal appointment. It is impressive that after an extensive global search and after subjecting the final candidates to four different rounds of formal interviews plus independent psychometric and intelligence tests, the best candidate was from within. This has many obvious advantages and materially less risk than an outside appointment, but more importantly, ensures Marcus Oldham's unique entrepreneurial and learning culture will live on.

New Management Structure

The College has grown materially over the last twenty years and to ensure it progressively evolves and excels in all core functions, the College has created a second Deputy Principal role which will be responsible for Culture and Development. This new structure will not be implemented until after the current Principal retires at the end of this calendar year. However, in practice, the College responsibilities will be split across three core executives being a Principal and two Deputy Principals.

Although the Principal is ultimately the responsible executive, below is a summary of the new structure and core responsibilities effective 1 January 2022.

<u>Andrew Baker - Principal</u> (academic programs, academic staff, accreditations, and course development)

<u>Tony McMeel - Deputy Principal Finance and Commercial</u> (finance function, building maintenance and capex, land development)

<u>Elizabeth Gubbins - Deputy Principal Development and Culture</u> (responsible for all functions outside of finance and academic programs). Staff reporting to this role will include foundation, scholarships and alumni, marketing, administration and student residential services. Elizabeth is an external appointment and will start her new role on 4 January 2022.
